Roles are mutually agreed upon. Positions are God ordained.

ROLE:

To empower is to love, to love is to confront, and to confront is to encourage.

POSITION:

To honour is to be humble, to be humble is to sacrifice, and to sacrifice is to be generous.

EMPOWER

Jesus empowered his disciples. In the same way, empower one another to fulfill your respective roles with excellence.

HONOUR

HUSBANDS: Honour your wife as Jesus honoured the church. WIVES: Honour your husband as you would Jesus.

LOVE

Everything Jesus did, He did out of love. In the same way, don't fulfil your role out of obligation or duty, but do it with love.

HUMILITY

HUSBANDS: Submitting to one another and receiving your wife's input takes humility. WIVES: Submitting yourself to your

CONFRONT

Jesus confronted every issue he faced. In the same way, don't ignore things that need attention. Confronting is coaching.

SACRIFICE

HUSBANDS: Laying down your life for your wife is to sacrifice your agenda. WIVES: Setting aside your ambitions to serve your family requires great sacrifice.

ENCOURAGE

Jesus was the great encourager. In the same way, encourage one another with support and appreciation and gratitude.

GENEROSITY

HUSBANDS: Be generous with your loving words and actions. WIVES: Be generous with your respectful words and actions.

Role + Position = RESPONSIBILITY

God's blueprint for happily ever after is activated when couples:

DEVELOP MATURITY

A commitment to EMPOWER one another from a place of HONOUR – **just as Jesus did for us**

EXTEND GRACE

A commitment to LOVE one another from a place of HUMILITY – **just as Jesus did for us**

BECOME COURAGEOUS

A commitment to CONFRONT issues from a place of SACRIFICE – **just as Jesus did for us**

CULTIVATE HOPE

A commitment to GENEROUSLY ENCOURAGE one another (words and actions) – **just as Jesus did for us**

MATURITY + GRACE + COURAGE + HOPE = GODLINESS

God has instituted an all-important "happily ever after" rescue plan right from the start. In MARRIAGE, THERE CAN BE NUMEROUS CHALLENGES BUT WITH

CHALLENGES, BUT WITH A **GODLY FORMULA, THERE'S** ALSO GREAT REDEMPTION.
